## ORBIT INTERNATIONAL CORP. POWER UNIT SEGMENT RECEIVES \$3.5 MILLION IN NEW ORDER TO SUPPORT F/A-18 AIRCRAFT

Hauppauge, New York, March 7, 2002—Orbit International Corp.(NASDAQ:ORBT) today announced that its Power Unit Segment, Behlman Electronics, Inc., has received an order for approximately \$3,500,000 from Raytheon Systems Company (NYSE:RTN) to build power supply assemblies for the Forward Looking Infrared Radar ("FLIR") system for the F/A-18 aircraft. The F/A-18 Hornet is a twin engine, mid-wing, multi-mission, all weather fighter and attack aircraft used by the Navy and Marine Corps. Deliveries under this contract are expected to commence in the fourth quarter of 2002 and continue through the fourth quarter of 2003.

Orbit also announced that with the addition of this new order, the consolidated backlog of the Company is approximately \$14,000,000, a 75% increase over the backlog from a year ago.

Dennis Sunshine, President and CEO commented, "We are pleased to have received this order from Raytheon after having previously supplied power supply assemblies directly to the government for this carrier based aircraft radar system. In addition to this order, Behlman is continuing to work with the government to design and supply additional subassemblies to support the FLIR system. We look forward to continuing to be a valued supplier to both the U.S. Government and Raytheon on these current and future program requirements."

Orbit International Corp., based in Hauppauge, New York is involved in the manufacture of customized electronic components and subsystems for military and nonmilitary government applications. Its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary manufactures and sells high quality commercial power units and low noise uninterruptable power supplies (UPS). The Behlman custom division designs, manufactures and sells power units and electronic products for measurement and display.
