## ORBIT INTERNATIONAL CORP. POWER UNIT SEGMENT RECEIVES NEW ORDER FROM HONEYWELL TO BE USED IN THE U.S. ARMY TALIN SYSTEM

Hauppauge, New York, June 4, 2002—Orbit International Corp. (NASDAQ:ORBT) today announced that its Power Unit Segment, Behlman Electronics, Inc., has received an order from Honeywell International, Inc. (NYSE:HON) for a power supply that will be used in the U.S. Army Tactical Advanced Land Inertial Navigator (TALIN) System. The TALIN system is a navigation system used in ground based vehicles for identifying both the vehicle and gun location.

The total purchase order, valued at approximately \$450,000, calls for the design and delivery of five (5) prototype and qualification units by December 2002 and production deliveries of 300 units that will commence after qualification testing approval. Deliveries of production units are expected throughout 2003. Because of its application, the Company believes this power supply has the potential for repeat orders in future years.

Dennis Sunshine, President and CEO of Orbit commented, "We are particularly pleased to have received this order because it represents the first that our Behlman unit has received from Honeywell. We look forward to becoming a valuable supplier of Commercial Off-The-Shelf (COTS) power supplies to Honeywell on future programs. Behlman's Custom Power Division has seen substantial growth in bookings over the past 18 months in orders for its COTS solutions for customer power requirements with several leading prime contractors for important military and governmental programs. This latest order once again demonstrates Behlman's ability to provide high-quality, cost-effective power solutions. It is also significant because it provides Behlman a new market in ground based vehicle applications."

Orbit International Corp., based in Hauppauge, New York, is involved in the manufacture of customized electronic components and subsystems for military and nonmilitary government applications. Its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary manufactures and sells high quality commercial power units and low noise uninterruptable power supplies (UPS). The Behlman custom division designs, manufactures and sells power units and electronic products for measurement and display.
