RECEIVES NEW ORDERS FOR \$625,000

Expected Follow-On Order Would Bring Total Orders To In Excess of \$1 Million

Hauppauge, New York, February 1, 2005—Orbit International Corp. (NASDAQ:ORBT) today announced that its Power Units Segment, Behlman Electronics, Inc. ("Behlman") has received an order for approximately \$345,000 for a power supply module used on the F/A-18 Forward Looking Infrared Radar ("FLIR") program. In addition, Behlman received an order for a power supply used in a railroad signaling application for the New York City Transit System totaling in excess of \$280,000 and expects a follow-on order for this same project, worth approximately \$400,000, for its state-of-the-art railroad signal power sources. Deliveries under these contracts are expected to commence in this first quarter of 2005 and continue through the fourth quarter of 2005.

Mark Tublisky, President of Behlman, commented, "The spares order for the F/A-18 FLIR program is for a power supply that Behlman had previously supplied to the Navy and is in addition to various other power supplies that Behlman manufactures in support of this program. Considering the large number of F/A-18's that are currently in service, the business potential remains quite significant for our Company."

Tublisky continued, "The new order from the New York City Transit System was achieved based on Behlman's reputation for providing individualized engineering support and unmatched service to our customers. We are confident that we will receive the follow-on order for our state-of-the-art railroad signal power sources in the near future."

Dennis Sunshine, President and Chief Executive Officer of Orbit International Corp. added, "Behlman continues to effectively execute its business plan as evidenced by its record bookings in 2004. We are very encouraged by the continued business activity in our Power Units Segment and we remain confident that we will continue to see sales growth in this Segment in 2005. Both our Power Units and Electronics Segments are continuing to pursue a number of new business opportunities that we expect to come to fruition in 2005. Consequently, we remain confident that our business will remain strong and with the pending addition of our previously announced agreement to acquire Tulip Development Laboratory, Inc, we expect very strong operating results in 2005."

Orbit International Corp., based in Hauppauge, New York, is involved in the manufacture of customized electronic components and subsystems for military and nonmilitary government applications. Its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary manufactures and sells high quality commercial power units, AC power sources, frequency converters, inverters,

uninterruptible power supplies and associated analytical equipment. The Behlman custom division designs, manufactures and sells power units and electronic products for military and high-end industrial usage.
